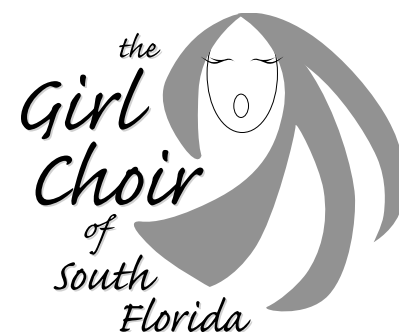

### 6. Arroz con Leche (Rice Pudding)

This is about a young man called "Rice Pudding" who is searching for a young widow to marry – someone who can sew, stitch, and satisfy his domestic needs. He does meet a widow, but ironically she is a princess, and it is now *she* who does the choosing.
